2019-2020 Preschool Registration

We will begin accepting registration forms for currently enrolled families on Tuesday, January 22. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis for currently enrolled students, and their siblings, and given priority until Wednesday, January 30. A non-refundable registration fee of \$70 is due at the time of registration. The one-time activity fee, due October 1, is \$40. Please let me know if you have any questions about the registration process!

Tuition for the 2019-2020 school year will be:

- \$138 for the 2-day session
- \$168 for the 3-day session, and
- \$198 for the 4-day session

Lunch Bunch

Lunch Bunch is offered Monday through Friday from 11:45 -1:45 and on Mondays and Wednesdays



from 10:30 - 12:30. There are separate sign-up books for the sessions. Lunch Bunch costs \$12 per session with punch cards available for \$60 & \$120. Parents provide lunch and the teachers provide more time for free play, large motor activity and a story in a relaxed and comfortable environment. Please remember to sign up one week in advance so we can provide adequate staffing.

From the Teacher: Art Supplies on a Budget, by Teacher Cindy

As we head into the long Minnesota winter, I know many of you might be looking for ways to fill the hours you'll be stuck inside with a restless preschooler. I thought I could offer you advice on how to stock up on art supplies without breaking the bank. The best place in the Twin Cities for awesome, cheap art supplies is *Art Scraps* in St. Paul. It's located at 1459 St. Clair Ave. They're open Mon.-Fri. 10am-6pm and Sat. 10am-4pm.

Art Scraps has a treasure trove of donated and recycled materials for all your creative needs. They have everything from bottle caps and fabric scraps to glow in the dark sticker paper. Bring your preschooler and \$10 and you'll find enough supplies to get you through those cold, winter afternoons.

Here are some supplies to have on hand to spark your child's creativity. You'll find that you have a lot of these things around your house and a trip to Art Scraps will give your preschooler a few extras.

Things to draw on: Paper, corrugated cardboard, recycled cardboard from cereal boxes, etc., cut up paper from grocery bags, wood, chalkboard

Things to draw and paint with: Crayola crayons, pens, pencils, watercolor paint, chalk, and oil pastels (they are inexpensive and an awesome artistic tool for kids)

Something to protect your table: A flannel-backed tablecloth from the Dollar Store

Things to collage with: Inexpensive odds and ends, fabric and ribbon scraps, stickers, cut up junk mail, paper scraps, buttons, yarn, scissors, colored masking tape, glue, a stapler

Things to sculpt with:

Here's our awesome play dough recipe!

- 2 ½ cups of flour
- ½ cup of salt
- 1 tsp cream of tartar
- 2 envelopes of Kool-Aid
- 3 Tbsp vegetable oil
- 2 cups water

Mix dry ingredients together in a large bowl. Bring oil and water to a boil in a small saucepan. Pour oil/water into dry ingredients. Mix. Cool a bit and knead. Store up to 2 weeks in an air-tight container.
